

[Wooden tobacco pipes](#) are made of wood and are usually used for smoking tobacco. These pipes are very popular with many people because they are cheap, durable, easy to use and clean.

There are various types of wooden tobacco pipes that you can choose from. Some of the most common types include:

The [Corncob Pipe](#): This type of pipe is very popular in America. It is made from the inner part of a cob, which is called the shuck. The top part of the shuck is removed and then it is drilled out until it becomes hollow. A stem is fitted into this hole so that air flows through it when you inhale smoke from your pipe.

The Meerschaum Pipe: This type of pipe is made from a mineral called meerschaum which is found in Turkey and other parts of Europe. Meerschaum pipes are carved out by hand and then painted with a mixture that includes beeswax along with other ingredients such as tree sap or resin. The paint helps to seal any cracks or holes that may appear on these pipes over time as they age, preventing them from losing their luster or becoming damaged due to water damage caused by moisture exposure over time if these cracks were left unsealed by not being painted over first before
